Background

Kathmandu University (KU) is an autonomous, not-for-profit, non - government institution dedicated to maintaining high standards of academic excellence. KU was established by the Act of the Parliament of Nepal in November 1991. KU has its origins in Kathmandu Valley Campus, which was founded in 1985 to run an Intermediate of Science program.

Within a period of 24 years, KU has not only built reasonable infrastructure, but also established a track record of academic excellence. The University offers various undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate programs in science, engineering, medicine, management, education, arts, law, pharmacy, environment, music, human & natural resources, information technology and biotechnology among others, through its School of Science, School of Management, School of Engineering, School of Medical Sciences, School of Education, School of Law and School of Arts.

Location

The University is has its central Campus in Dhulikhel which is located at a distance of about 30 kilometers east of Kathmandu Valley. Spread over 18.11 hectares of land, the University enjoys a hilly landscape and panoramic views of the Himalayas.

KU also has its School of Management in Balkumari, Lalitpur and School of Education and School of Arts at Hattiban, Lalitpur.
